We are pleased to be able to welcome parents and carers for our second parent consultation meeting of the year. These consultations are an important method for us in communicating how your child is progressing at school, how they're developing personally and how we can work together to support them. It is vital that you attend a meeting for your child, because working together will make a significant difference to your child's development.

Parent consultations will be held in your child's classroom – accessed through the school hall. Each room will have an allocated waiting room, where you can view your child's learning prior to the meeting. Accompanying children must stay with parents at all times, due to the site being 'open'.

We operate a ten minute appointment system and you can book your appointment easily and electronically through Parentmail from 11am on Friday 23rd January 2026..You will be able to choose the time slot yourself, so early booking is advised.
