## Year 6 Final Dates and Arrangements

### Paulton's Park

Monday 29<sup>th</sup> June: Students should arrive at school at the usual start time and will return to school by 5.15pm. Please ensure you're available for collection at this time – children will not be allowed to walk home on this day. Children will need to bring a packed lunch (unless you have ordered one from school), a water bottle and sunhat. Please also ensure that suncream is to your child. Children may wear clothing that will help keep them cool (this does not need to be school uniform; a white PE top is recommended), along with suitable footwear for a full day of walking. Please ensure clothing provides appropriate coverage, particularly for areas not usually exposed to the sun, and is suitable for a full day outdoors. The weather looks to be much cooler next week but we will update with any changes nearer the time if need be.
