In this edition of our reading newsletter, you will find some great requests to Father Christmas for a few books that will engage children and support their reading enjoyment.

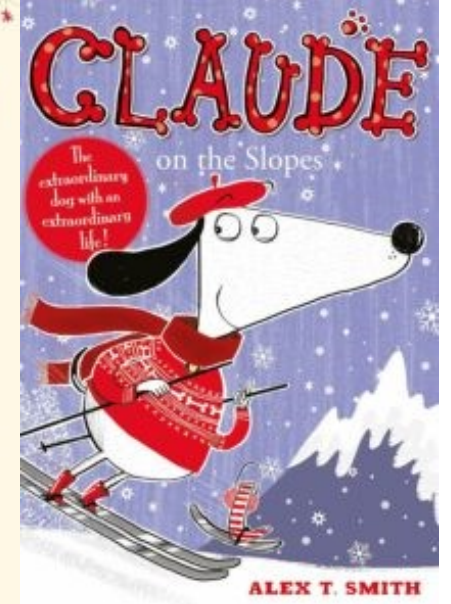
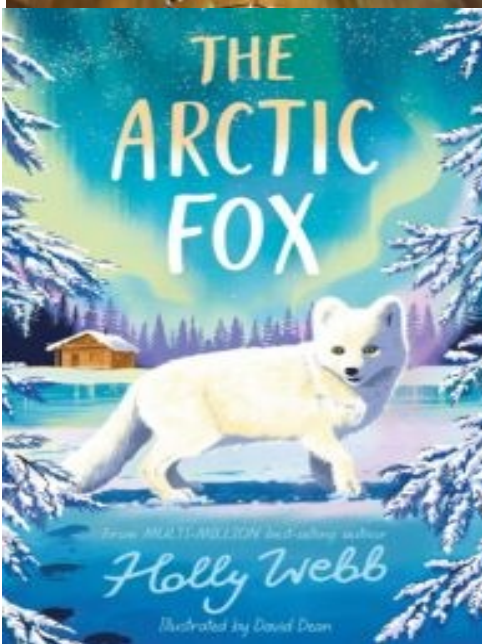
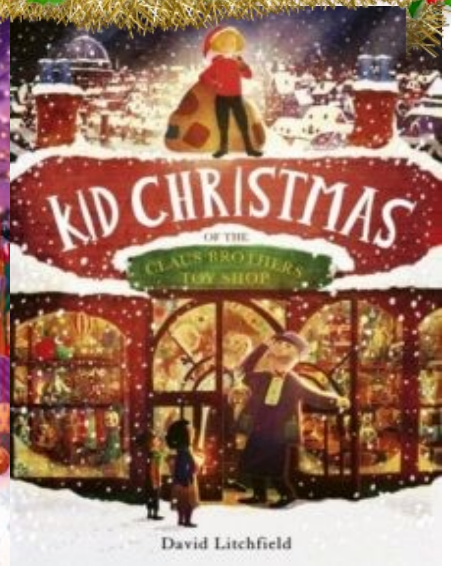
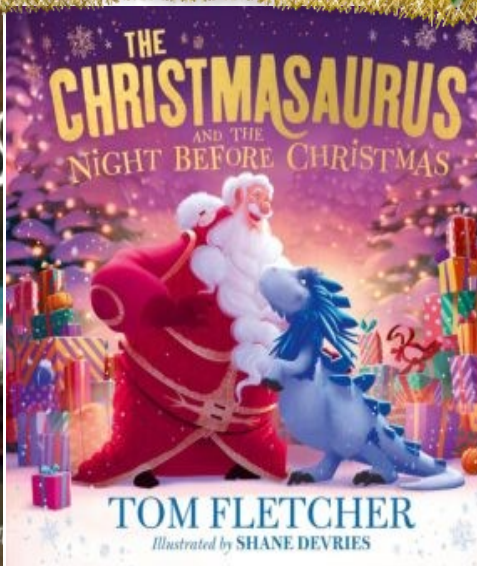
